But men who reported drinking two or three cups of coffee a day were 10 percent less likely to have died than those who didn't drink coffee, while women drinking the same amount had 13 percent less risk of dying during the study. It's not clear exactly what coffee had to do with their longevity, but the correlation is striking.
- 10 ~~7~~ B. But a cup or three of coffee "has been popular for a long, long time," Dr. Freund says, "and there's probably good reasons for that."

In one large-scale epidemiological study from last year, researchers primarily at the National Cancer Institute parsed health information from more than 400,000 volunteers, ages 50 to 71, who were free of major diseases at the study's start in 1995. By 2008, more than 50,000 of the participants had died.

Other recent studies have linked moderate coffee drinking — the equivalent of three or four 5-ounce cups of coffee a day or a single venti-size Starbucks — with more specific advantages: a decrease in the risk of developing Type 2 diabetes, the most common skin cancer and oral cancer recurrence.
