The benefits of studying in Russia

Purpose

A survey based on a series of interviews conducted recently among students from European and Asian countries as well as the US has revealed the most common reasons that encourage foreign students to enroll at Russian universities. The aim of this report is to analyze these reasons and outline the main trends. The report also contains a forecast of future changes.

Reasons

The vast majority of European and Asian students are likely to opt for Russian universities due to the complex and extensive education, which is highly esteemed worldwide. Moreover, international students are usually offered scholarships, which is considered a highly important advantage for European and American students; however, only 16% of Asian applicants take this benefit into account. What really matters for Asian students is the fact that Russian universities provide them with an opportunity to receive dual diplomas, while as much as 24% of them greatly appreciate the variety of educational programmes to choose from. Though international students encounter the possibilities for easier adaptation, only a small percentage of them consider it significant.

Possible future changes

Due to the abundance of educational facilities providing comprehensive education, the recent statistics are likely to change. The percentage of students that value the scholarships might reach 50% and 44% for European and Asian students respectively. There may be a sudden increase in the number of applicants that esteem the amount of educational programmes available, as students start to understand the importance and value of qualitative education.

Conclusion

Education has always been a powerful weapon. Thankfully, Russian universities possess it, not only allowing their students to study, but also providing the necessities for their future well-being. Therefore, Russian educational programmes will always be highly esteemed.
