Introduction It is evident that more and more students all over the world choose to study abroad every year. What motivates them to do so? I have conducted a survey among 155 foreign exchange students in our university. The aim of this report is to analyze and compare this data, speculate on the possible ~~reasoning~~ reasons and future developments.

Trends and comparisons

The most popular reason both among bachelor degree students and master degree students is having future career prospects (34% and 47% respectively), although the latter seem to appreciate that aspect more. Another popular reason in both groups is the addition of language learning prospects (15%).


18%). The explanation to this is that both types all types of students are interested in learning and getting a good career. Nowadays a lot of employees are expected to know more than one language. The bachelor degree students are studying abroad to increase their maturity and self-confidence (21%), while the master degree students are not very interested in that aspect (5%). The opposite situation can be seen in such responses about travelling opportunities (4%, 14%). This can be explained with the ages of these groups. Equal parts of participants chose better understanding of cultural Future development values and biases, as this advantage is not affected by age.

Future development

I can only assume that studying abroad will not recede in popularity any time soon. It offers very attractive advantages for students of all age groups and levels of education: while bachelor degree students will enjoy the language learning prospects and increased maturity, the other group will pay attention to the future career prospects.
