Task 4

Both texts cover the concern of many successful companies, the four-day workweek. They are aimed at comparing all the pros and cons of implementing this schedule.

The first text's main idea suggests that working less can be more effective, therefore bringing in more revenue. As an explanation of such impact, it is noted that all the hours previously spent in office now can be filled with exciting activities, get-togethers or studies. However, both texts mention the potential struggles of industries in constant need of workforce in case they consider reducing working hours. Moreover, the second text brings to pay attention to other minor and major inconveniences, while questioning whether changes expected are positive or negative. It is claimed that lower efficiency and higher stress are to become more common, not the other way around. Even though both texts suggest the necessity of analysis before any changes begin in a business, I think most companies, excluding state organisations can find a way to shorten a workweek, therefore resulting in productivity increase.

Overall, two texts explore both negative and positive sides of a problem. While the first text presents more optimistic view on decreasing the time spent at work, the second one tends to be realistic, if not doubtful about this schedule.
